12:45-1:45	Edwin Geronimo Sarah Mark Yvette Rock	Participants are encouraged to use this time to visit and interact with installation artists: Edwin Geronimo – installation and live art inside the Live Coal Arts Mobile. Edwin’s art is an expression of his own life experiences and gives voice to boldly address culture’s injustices to bring awareness, healing and change within individuals and society. Sarah Mark – installing a fiber art piece she worked on for six years, all with the purpose of seeking inner healing from the loss of her first child. The work is composed of ten panels all slightly overlapping to create one visual landscape of souls ascending in an upward direction from one reality to the next. The piece will be installed in the former baptismal room of Light Box. The space will offer viewers the opportunity to be in a quiet, meditative space with only a few viewers allowed in the room at a time. Yvette Rock – setting up a space where participants can engage in making their own works of art related to memory, loss, grieving, healing, and more through writing, collage, and mixed media. Yvette will create a larger piece based on the artistic contributions of participants. For those who have lost loved ones, the artist encourages you to bring a photograph or object associated with loved one to	

		incorporate in piece. This “Communal Grieving & Healing Quilt” will be installed inside Light Box towards the end of the day.

Participants are encouraged to share openly and honestly about work they made and interactions and reflections they had. Participants can also use this time to just listen to others share.
